UPCOMING PROJECT INFORMATION TRUMBULL COUNTY ENGINEER PROPOSES SIDEWALK PROJECT ON YOUNGSTOWN KINGSVILLE ROAD/STATE ROUTE 193 AND WARREN SHARON ROAD/COUNTY ROUTE 329 IN VIENNA TOWNSHIP

The Trumbull County Engineer in cooperation with Vienna Township proposes to install new sidewalk along Youngstown Kingsville Road/State Route (SR) 193 and Warren Sharon Road/County Route (CR) 329 connecting neighborhoods to the Mathews High School complex. The project proposes to construct a total of 1,920 feet of new concrete sidewalk along the east side of Youngstown Kingsville Road from Roselawn Terrace to Warren Sharon Road and along the south side of Warren Sharon Road from Youngstown Kingsville Road to the Mathews School complex. Additional improvements include new curb, curb ramps/truncated domes to comply with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards, catch basin reconstruction and new crosswalk/stop line applications, as necessary, throughout the project limits. No new permanent and/or temporary right-of-way is needed to construct the project.

The \$214,050 project is scheduled for construction in the summer 2022. During construction, a minimum of one lane of traffic shall be maintained on Youngstown Kingsville Road and Warren Sharon Road at all times. Access shall also be maintained to all adjacent properties, businesses, and intersection streets for the duration of the project.

To ensure the decision-making process is comprehensive, Trumbull County Engineer, Randy Smith, is seeking comments from the public about the social, environmental and economic impacts of this proposed project. Environmental impacts include those involving archeological, architectural and ecological resources, regulated materials and the general location of the project. Trumbull County Engineer also requests information regarding the presence of any known cultural resources in the vicinity of the project including prehistoric and historic archaeological sites, historic bridges, historic buildings, landmarks and districts.
