#### UPCOMING PROJECT INFORMATION: TRUMBULL COUNTY ENGINEER PLANS BRIDGE REHABILITATION ALONG PAINESVILLES WARREN STATE ROAD IN SOUTHLINGTON TOWNSHIP

Trumbull County Engineer, Randy Smith, has identified the desperate condition of many of the 377 bridges throughout Trumbull County and is committed to providing the necessary resources to address this problem. The project proposes to rehabilitate the existing bridge carrying Painesville Warren State Road over Dead Branch between Doty East Road and Leiby Osborne Road by replacing the existing deteriorated bridge deck. This project is scheduled to begin construction in the spring/summer 2023.

During construction, Painesville Warren State Road at the bridge site will be closed to traffic for a maximum of seventy-five (75) consecutive calendar days. The official detour for this project will utilize State Routes (SR) 305 and 534. Construction and bridge closure/detour information will be posted along Painesville Warren State Road, along intersecting side roads and on the Trumbull County Engineer webpage, <http://engineer.co.trumbull.oh.us>, prior to the start of construction activities. Access shall be maintained to all properties within and adjacent to the project construction limits for the duration of project construction.

While no environmental impacts are anticipated during project construction, Trumbull County Engineer, Randy Smith, is seeking any comments you may have regarding the proposed project, maintenance of traffic, etc.
