UPCOMING PROJECT INFORMATION TRUMBULL COUNTY ENGINEER PLANS RESURFACING ON NILES VIENNA ROAD IN VIENNA, HOWLAND & WEATHERSFIELD TOWNSHIPS

Trumbull County Engineer, Randy Smith, proposes to improve Niles Vienna Road (C.H. 56) in Liberty Township, Trumbull County, Ohio. The project proposes to mill and resurface 4.05 miles of Niles Vienna Road from Warren Sharon Road to the Niles City Corporation Limits. Additional improvements include the replacement of one (1) cross culvert located between Smith Stewart Road and State Route (SR) 82, the installation of a new full-height concrete headwall on an existing culvert located between SR 82 and Warren Sharon Road, partial depth pavement repairs, replacement of existing guardrail at three (3) locations, installation of new guardrail at four (4) locations and the application of edge/center/stop lines and other pavement markings throughout the newly paved section of Niles Vienna Road. This \$1,289,540 project is scheduled to begin construction in the summer of 2021.

Traffic shall be maintained at all times along Niles Vienna Road during project construction, except when it will be necessary to close Niles Vienna Road for a maximum of three (3) consecutive days during the replacement of the cross culvert located between Smith Stewart Road and SR 82. The official detour for this closure will utilize Scoville North Road and SR 82. Construction, lane restrictions, road closure and detour information will be posted along Niles Vienna Road and on the Trumbull County Engineer webpage, <http://engineer.co.trumbull.oh.us>, prior to the start of construction activities. Access shall be maintained to all adjacent properties and intersecting side streets within the construction limits for the duration of the project.

To ensure the decision-making process is comprehensive, Trumbull County Engineer, Randy Smith, is seeking comments from the public about the social, environmental and economic impacts of this proposed project. Environmental impacts include those involving archeological, architectural and ecological resources, regulated materials and the general location of the project. Trumbull County Engineer also requests information regarding the presence of any known cultural resources in the vicinity of the project including prehistoric and historic archaeological sites, historic bridges, historic buildings, landmarks and districts.
